## Agreed points:

- The School needs the top 20 strategic suppliers from each of the partners to engage them in the School and to up-skill them.
- It was agreed that next year the School and partners should concentrate on companies in their supply chain that can make a difference rather than quantity of lists.
- Partners to choose the strategic suppliers based on their affectivity by looking at engineering impact/ capability.
