Step 5: Once a resource has been completed, the grey box eside each will automatically tick itself.



<u>Step 8:</u> Once you have completed each resource, you can progress to the learning pathway quiz (*the last resource on the list*).



<u>Step 9:</u> You need to complete (and pass) the quiz. The questions are based on the resources you have just watched and you must achieve a score of 80% or to pass (*you can re-take the quiz if you need to*).





Step 10: Once you have completed the pathway, your account will update automatically to give you the Highways England "Level 1" badge and also mark your completion via the learning pathway itself.

NB: You MUST complete level 1 before you can enrol in and undertake level 2.
