1	Welcome and Intros		
2	<ul> <li>Plant Commitment Charter</li> <li>The Charter and all relevant information – the Minimum Standards and news items - are available <a href="here">here</a>.</li> <li>Organisations who have not signed up and wish to should contact James. We are happy to explain the purpose and its benefits.</li> <li>There have been 3 new signatories since the last meeting: Amery, Select Hire, and the Environment Agency</li> </ul>	Organisations who want to sign up to the plant charter.	
3	<ul> <li>Reviewing the Minimum Standards</li> <li>The working group met in March to discuss the information gleaned from the interviews with OEMs and what that means for updating the Minimum Standards.</li> <li>The Group discussed making difference in the updated Minimum Standards between plant that is bought new, and plant that is hired, to take into account fleet lifetimes.</li> <li>This is work in progress and we will update the wider Plant Group as matters develop.</li> </ul>		
4	<ul> <li>The Clean Air Zone map has been produced and is in a final version, available for viewing here.</li> <li>This map details the Clean Air Zone and Low Emission Zones that are either active or in consultation in the UK.</li> <li>The map will undergo periodic review to keep it up-to-date, indeed an update has already been made.</li> <li>The Group confirmed that it would also be helpful to see Clean Air Zone that are currently only relevant to buses as they show the direction of travel that a given authority is considering for reducing poor air quality.</li> </ul>		



5	<ul> <li>The first of the Plant Commitment Charter's commitments states "Minimum standards in procurement: We will buy or hire CPE that meets or exceeds the minimum standards for AQ and GHG emissions, as laid out in the latest version of accompanying technical paper"</li> <li>Now that the Charter has been in existence since May 2020 it was agreed that the time is right to develop a process for measuring adherence to the Charter</li> <li>We asked the Group what to do an exercise to determine what reporting should be undertaken against the Charter and the Minimum Standards. What should be reported, how, what frequency, to whom, and what should be done with the information.</li> <li>The outputs are in the accompanying PDF. The next steps are to review the information and provide the Group with a strawman for review of how signatories can report against the Charter.</li> </ul>	James and Imogen
