Through implementation of our Environmental Management System, we aim to continually reduce our impact by:

- Reviewing our fleet procurement strategy towards hybrid and electric vehicles
- Reviewing our energy procurement strategy towards
 renewable energy
- Surveying our owned buildings to install photovoltaic solar panels
- Establishing and maintaining relationships with our local communities

Impact:

Being a member of the School and accessing its resources has had a positive impact on our business and enabled us to increase staff knowledge and meet our client needs. The following are some areas where the school has helped facilitate positive change within the company:

- Modern Slavery: After attending a Supply Chain Sustainability School seminar, we ran a Modern Slavery awareness campaign to highlight to staff where we may be exposed within our supply chain. The campaign included posters, inclusion in our annual QHSE briefing roadshow to all management staff including a video and new modern slavery awareness toolbox talks.
