Net Zero Policy Tracker 2021 (Intermediate) A report monitoring the difference new government policy and spending is making to the shortfall in action towards reaching UK climate change targets.

Industrial Decarbonisation Strategy 2021 (Intermediate) The UK Government's Industrial Decarbonisation Strategy lays out long-term plans to switch away from fossil fuel combustion to low carbon alternatives in all UK industry sectors.

WMO State of the Climate 2020 (Advanced) A report from the World Meteorological Association on changes in atmospheric GHGs, temperature, ice sheets, sea level and severe weather events in 2020 and their environmental and human impacts.

<u>Climate Policy Dashboard</u> (Advanced) The Climate Policy Dashboard tracks policy progress towards net zero against key recommendations made in the last 12 months by the Climate Change Committee (CCC).

<u>Greenhouse Gas Removal</u> (Advanced) This report identifies the range of available greenhouse gas removal methods, the factors that will affect their use and considers how they may be deployed together to meet climate targets in the UK and globally.



FREE Carbon Calculator

The Sustainability Tool's <u>carbon calculator</u> has been specifically designed for carbon management in the supply chain. The tool can support supply chain organisations with calculating their annual, organisational greenhouse gas emissions, and provide their clients with a view of emissions

embedded in their supply chains.
