- ECI work allowed for




Lot Structure:



Regional Lots (Lots 2-4)

Year 1:

- Allocation on a rotational basis.
- Supplier who receives the highest tender score on the Regional Lot will receive the earliest work order. Year 2*:
- Value Allocation using a forward programme of work.
- The Supplier who had the highest tender score on the Regional Lot will be allocated the highest value Work Order

Years 3 & 4*:

- Allocation of Work Orders according to value will be on a combination of performance scores and tender scores to rank suppliers
- * Providing a forward programme of work is available.

Secondary Competition

Will be used where:-

• No forward programme of works is available

Or:-

• When other contracting bodies (not HE) are awarding a Work Order.
