Welcome and Introductions

The Partners were informed that Kevin Shackson from SEWSCAP is now the vice Chair of the Wales Leadership Group.

General School Update:

David Emery, Sector Lead for Wales informed the group that the School now has 172 Partners. Please see the image below for the Partners have joined the School recently:



The group was also shown the School performance for April 2022 in comparison to the School performance in April 2021. Active individuals have increased by 31% and active companies have increased by 37%. There was however a decrease in learning hours of -27% this was due to 4 Business Bytes taking place in 2021 in comparison to 1 delivered in 2022. 2 of the Business Bytes delivered in 2021 were launch events so therefore gained more attendance. There were also more Lunch 'n' Learns delivered in April 2022 (13) compared to 6 which were delivered in 2021 which equates to less learning time.

Improvement Skillset

Mark Worrall from BBI Services was introduced to the group to discuss the Improvement Skillset. The objective of the improvement skillset is to build your teams capability to make a difference to productivity, quality & performance.

Mark explained to the group what the programme entails and the opportunities available for Partners to build their teams capability which are:


Supply Chain Sustainability School Summit
