

Case Study: Komfort Services

Challenges:

The construction industry faces enormous pressure to be at the forefront in driving sustainability and innovation through construction, design and build. Examples include sourcing sustainable products and materials, providing new builds, meeting BREEAM standards, and demonstrating a percentage of works to be delivered through energy-efficient measures.

Komfort Services has experienced the increasing requirement to evidence sustainable business practices at the tender stage with high expectations. Meeting these practices has proven challenging when competing in a wider arena and against larger businesses with a broader resource infrastructure within the sustainability sector.

Impact:

Komfort Services has benefitted from learning with the School. It has resulted in them appointing environmental champions within the company, whose role is to endorse and encourage feedback and ideas from the staff.

Electric Fleet: To reduce emissions, Komfort Services has started to roll out an electric fleet. While this has always been a company aspiration, the benefits of reducing carbon emissions were reinforced through the Net Zero modules provided by the School.

CSR & Social Value: Komfort Services has looked at ways of increasing CSR and, as a result, won Social Value accreditation with Constructionline. The company are also on Surrey County Council's Social Value Marketplace, and now run an Apprenticeship scheme in the various trades they offer. The School has provided excellent information on this topic, which made Komfort Services take this aspect of their offering even more seriously. The company also saw an increasing trend of social value requirements in tenders.

Sponsorships: Another way Komfort Services has increased its CSR is by sponsoring local youth football and cricket clubs that help keep troubled teenagers off the streets and provide them with an outlet that supports their mental health and wellbeing. The company looked at various causes to support through its donations. The School's resource on Mind and the power of sport and physical activity to raise awareness and tackle mental health stigmas contributed to Komfort Services' decision to support youth sports.

Sustainable Procurement: Komfort Services is working with its supply chain and looking at increasing its offering to clients by providing them with more environmentally friendly alternatives. The company also utilises this approach at the tender stage as the requirement for sustainable provisions is more stringent. The School's E-learning modules on BES 6001 Responsible Sourcing and Embedding Sustainable

Benchmarking: Komfort Services found the School assessments very useful in testing their knowledge and providing a benchmark for measuring the company's performance and continual improvement. The company have also found the resulting action plans to be thought-provoking as they make them more aware of areas that they need to focus on and provide useful insight.

Value gained:

Improving business practices: As a result of learning with the School, Komfort Services has revised its environmental processes and policies and re-inducted its workforce. The company found workshops such as 'Carbon' and 'Delivering Energy and Carbon Efficient Buildings' thought-provoking and enabled them to implement a more robust foundation through its company-wide processes.

Sustainability is high on the company's agenda: After learning more about what sustainability is through the School, the issue of sustainability is now a standing item on Komfort Services' management meeting's agenda.

Competitive edge: When Komfort Services bids for future work, they are now more equipped in their knowledge and expertise to provide examples, innovative and sustainable products, and energy reduction measures. This will give the end client added value and contribute towards their carbon management plan.

Waste management: Through learning more about waste management, the company has upped its ability to re-cycle project waste from 80% to 99%, and provided detailed reporting on this to their clients.

Reputation by association: Reaching Silver Status has given the company better recognition, due to the School's strong reputation. Komfort Services' commitment to achieving Gold will provide added accreditation and demonstrate their passion for being better at what they do and how they deliver it.

Future proofing:
