# Scheme Overview



The AmeySRM works at this junction included –

- Building a two-way link across the junction to allow better connection between the M6 and A556
- A new bridge spanning the M6 motorway within the roundabout.
- Renewing traffic signals on the roundabout and its approach roads
- Adding traffic signals for the Tabley Hill Lane/ Pickmere Lane junction
- New signs, and improving the local access for walkers and cyclist using the junction.

Project Budget - £43 million

# A533 Expressway Bridge Replacement



# A533 - Scheme Overview



- Existing bridge is at the end of its serviceable life which provides opportunities to improve the road network.
- The concrete bridge carries the A533 over the M56 motorway between junctions 11 and 12.
- Construct new structure then demolish the existing structure.
- The replacement will improve this important link for motorists and provide dedicated access for pedestrians, horse riders and cyclists.
- The scheme is also to return the M56 motorway beneath to its original layout where it has been temporarily realigned to accommodate a bridge propping scheme.
- A vital local link, providing access to Runcorn from Preston Brook and Northwich.

**Project Budget - £27 million**

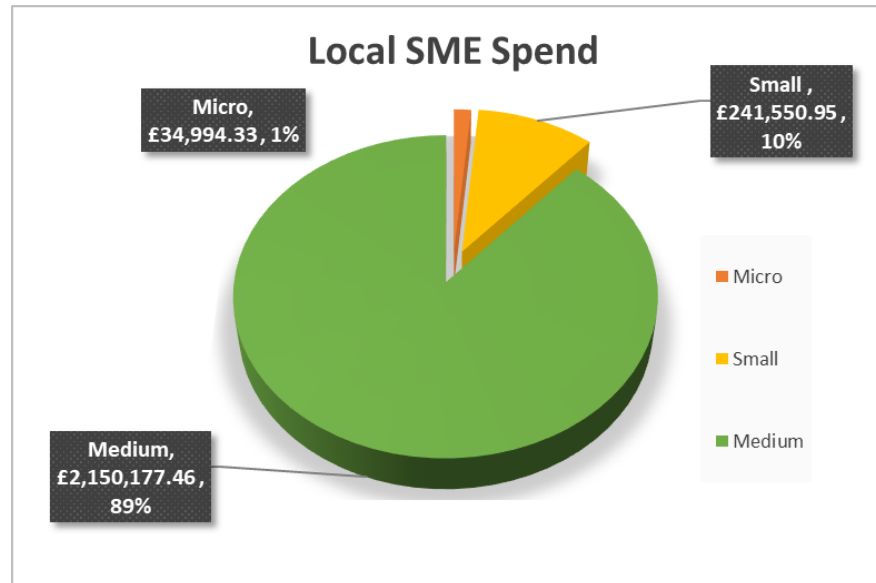
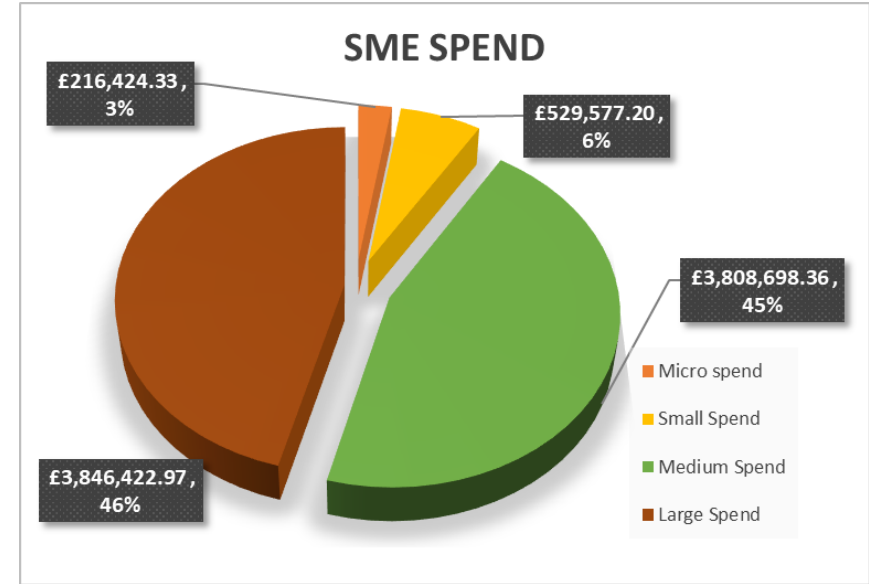
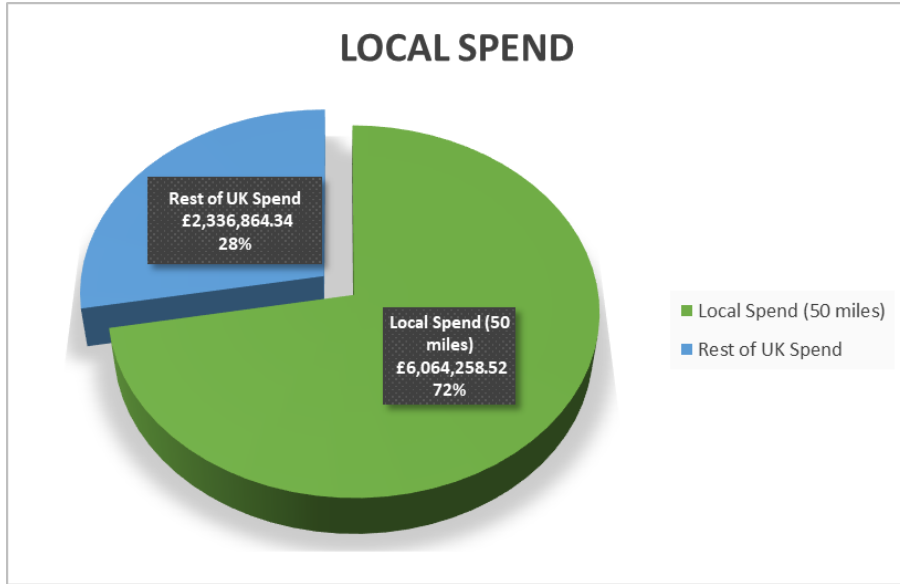
