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# Objectives

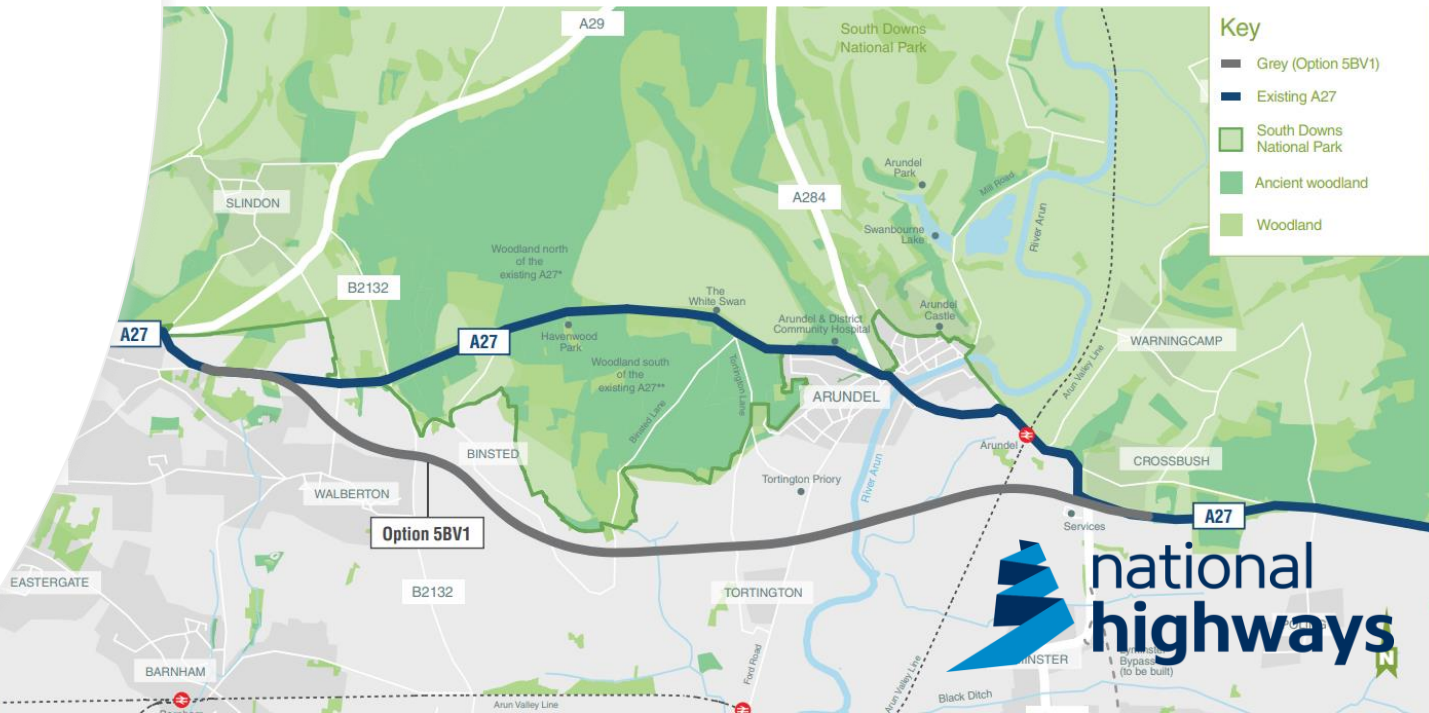
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- Improve capacity, more reliable journey time, reduce delays
- Enhance facilities for local residents, pedestrians, cyclists, and equestrians
- Reduce accidents through Arundel
- Zero impact on ancient woodland
- Deliver a scheme with a minimum of 10% Biodiversity Net Gain. Target is +24%



# Scheme Overview

- Around Historic Arundel
- The 8km “missing link” of dual carriageway between Crossbush and Fontwell
- Route Selection made in October 2020, longest route selected ‘Grey’ 5BV1
- Environmentally sensitive and significant project.
- Route avoids South Downs National Park

# Scheme Overview



## Scope

- Completion of grade separated Junction at Crossbush
- New western tie in West of Golf Course
- Route passes through Golf Course, significant areas of farmland
- Demolition of a number of houses and properties
- 10 new structures including
  - Railway crossing underbridge
  - River Arun underbridge
  - Two watercourses (Rifes)
- River Arun Floodplain crossing (C.1.5km)
- Cutting depths up to 8m
- Retaining walls up to 8m
- Poor Ground conditions!

## Engagement – Statutory consultation

- The Statutory Consultation ran for 6 weeks from early Jan 2022
- 4,161 organisations and people provided feedback
- We had 4,412 visitors to our website
- We had 3,836 visitors to our virtual consultation room
- More than 1,100 people visited our in-person events to find out more about the designs for the Scheme, speak directly to the National Highways team and share their feedback.
