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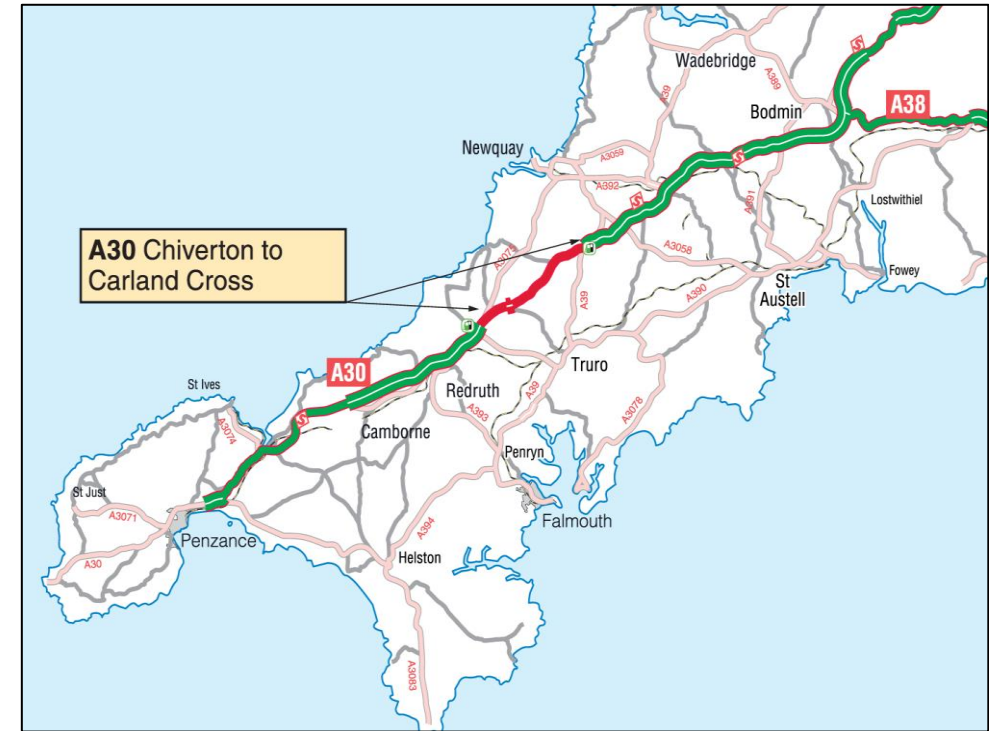
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A30 Chiverton to Carland Cross

Scheme Overview

- Scheme is upgrading the A30 north of Truro
- Delivered by National Highways RDP Framework
- Costain appointed as Delivery Integration Partner
- Contract Award/Start of Works 31 March 2020
- Open For Traffic 31 December 2023
- Project Budget £330 million



- Offline construction of D2AP carriageway, 8.7 miles long
- Grade separated junctions at Chiverton, Chybucca and Carland Cross
- Retaining and de-trunking the existing A30 for local traffic
- Additional provision for WCH (walkers, cyclists & horse riders)

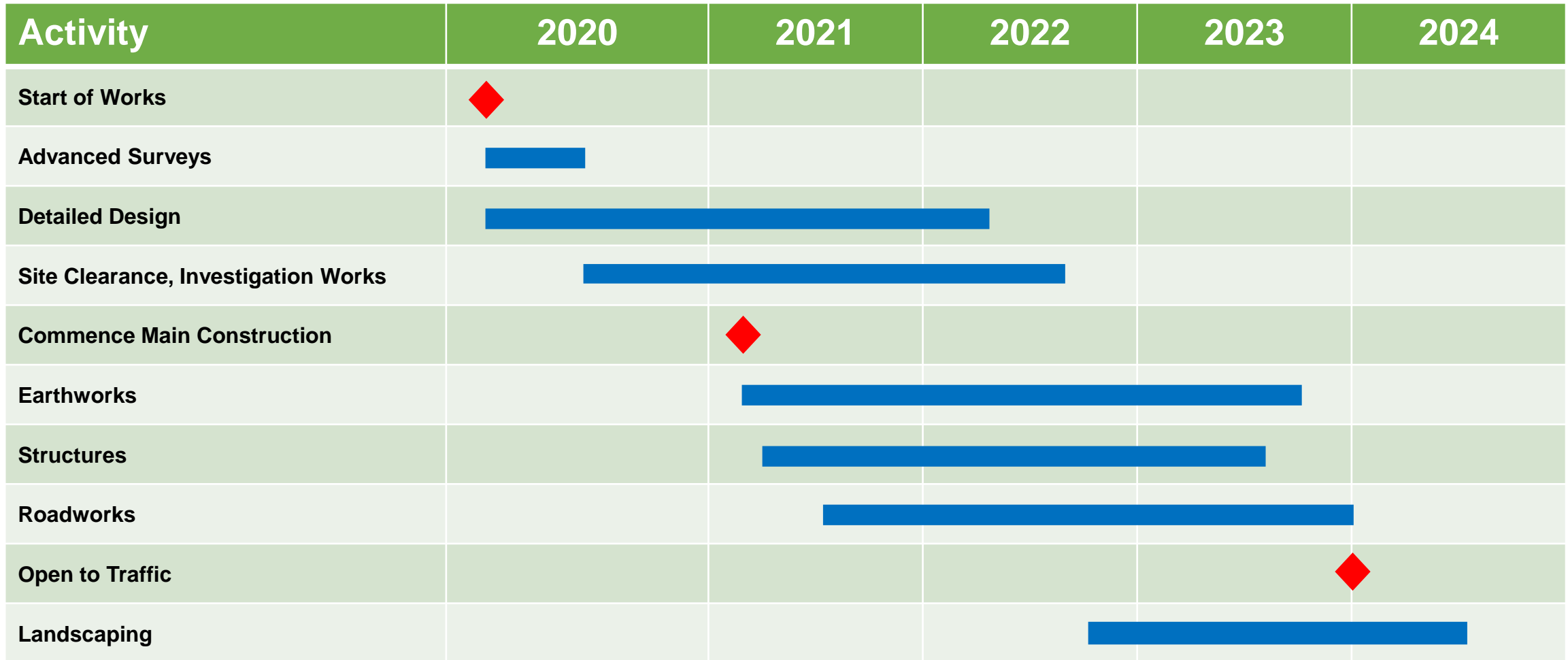
Works Summary & Objectives

- 13 new structures (under and overbridges)
- Refurbishment of existing underbridge and demolition of existing overbridge
- C.1.7 million m³ of earthworks
- 33 new culverts and multi-species crossings and 46km of new drainage
- Over 20km miles of wildlife proof fencing and 12.5km of new Cornish hedgerow



- Improve safety, reduce congestion & improve efficiency
- Unlock economic growth
- Connect communities & maintain routes
- Minimise disruption during construction
- Protect the environment

What have we done to date?

- Over 50% of awarded contracts have gone to businesses headquartered in Cornwall (c.20% of value of awarded contracts)
- c75% of tender lists have included businesses headquartered in Cornwall
- Legacy deliverables included in all awarded packages in excess of £1m
- Local SME engagement
- Supplier-pool market research exercises
- Compliance pre-qualification support
- Plant and Material suppliers sourced from local area
- Use of regional CECA agents to add knowledge on local Supply Chain
