

Challenges:

As a distributor for moveable partition systems, Style typically operates as a subcontractor, working on behalf of the principal contractor. Their products contribute to projects that are striving to meet BREEAM, LEED, SKA, and WELL standards.

Style is obligated to provide evidence that the products being incorporated within builds are sustainably manufactured, delivered, and installed. They actively source manufacturing partners who can furnish relevant evidence pertaining to Environmental Product Declaration and FSC certification.

To maximise transport efficiency, shipments are combined between regional offices, thus reducing redundant space on vehicles. Style's logistics partners in the UK hold FORS accreditation and function as licensed Waste Carriers for the removal of shipment packaging from sites. Moreover, the company's operatives undergo Environmental Awareness training.

Impact:

Sustainability advancement impact: Engagement with the Supply Chain Sustainability School has facilitated the organisation and prioritisation of sustainability within Style's operations. Regional champions have been assigned to engage with the School, ensuring the company keeps pace with industry requirements and opportunities in this area.

In collaboration with manufacturing partners, Style's offerings to the UK market include certified products that carry an Environmental Product Declaration. The company can demonstrate FSC certification and contribute evidence to projects striving to meet BREAAM, LEED, SKA, and WELL standards. Style operates a UKAS-accredited ISO 14001:2015 Environmental Management System.

The School has also provided insights and aspirations to improve Style's Quality Systems. A customer satisfaction feedback process is currently under development, which will facilitate proactive engagement with customers, encourage their feedback, and help improve services where applicable.

Illuminating strengths & weaknesses: The School's assessments have served to spotlight areas of strength within Style, while also asking insightful questions that probe less developed aspects of the business. While some of the School's wide-ranging topics fall outside of Style's scope as a niche subcontractor, the regular assessments have enabled the company to refocus on new areas, with a view to continuously improving operations.
