Water Industry Project

Dyanne van de Wijdeven introduced the piece of work she has been working on in relation to tendering for the AMP8 cycle in the water sector.

With the aim of sector alignment, Dyanne asked the Group for input on supplier performance incentives that drive supplier collaboration and sustainability. The discussion covered the following topics: positive incentives, Project 13 delivery model, and shared incentives, using Mentimeter to collect feedback and comments.
