6<sup>th</sup> September 2023 'Understanding the PMC/People Assessment': This will include a live assessment against the School's People assessment, introducing the maturity assessment guidance published in January 2023. This will help attendees understand more about good practice and enable them to benchmark their own progress against other attendees. This assessment will help inform questions that partners have been asking of the supply chain about what they're doing around wages, employment conditions, modern slavery, human rights etc as per the PMCs 8 conditions.

**8**<sup>th</sup> **November Virtual Conference on PMC:** We are looking for partner speakers to contact us if they are willing to speak about how their organisation has tackled a specific commitment in the charter. Ciara said she would be happy to talk about training and skills.

Workshop – Common heatmapping approach to modern slavery and labour exploitation risks

The group was divided into smaller groups to discuss the output they would like to see from the risk assessment workstream. Two outputs were given for the groups to decide which one they would prefer, these were:

- 1) A product/services risk assessment; or
- 2) A guidance document/presentation on how to undertake a risk assessment?

Each group then fed back the discussions they had with the whole group and it was felt that the 2<sup>nd</sup> option (guidance document/presentation) was the more favoured output. This guide would be done across a number of categories.
