

Case Study: Birtley Group

Challenges:

This collaboration effectively closes the loop in production and significantly reduces waste disposal. For instance, their UPVC supplier delivers profile materials that Birtley Group uses to manufacture door frames. Any off-cuts and particulates from the cutting and forming processes are collected and returned to the supplier for recycling during subsequent profile deliveries.

Impact:
