

Case Study: Community Wood Recycling

Challenges:

The UK produces more than 4.5 million tonnes of waste wood every year. Community Wood Recycling works with the construction industry to save this material from the waste stream and reuse it where possible in local communities. The company's lightweight trucks reduce CO2 emissions and airborne particulate matter. Sustainability is at the heart of what the company does, and as a network of small social enterprises, it needs resources that allow it to keep abreast of best practices in the sector and consider the environmental impact of all aspects of its operations. Community Wood Recycling is a supplier for the country's top construction companies. It is important for the company to maintain the levels of regulatory and compliance standards that its clients require, and to ensure that its ethical and employment policies also meet the highest standards.

Community Wood Recycling provides training opportunities for the people who work and volunteer with the company, and it needs access to up-to-date, well-designed, and engaging learning materials.
