
Welcome to the Supply Chain Sustainability School

Glossary

Training Workshops

As a Partner, you gain access to up to five training workshops led by sustainability specialists. You can choose from a wide array of over 50 subjects, covering vital sustainability topics such as carbon reduction, social value, Design for Manufacture and Assembly (DfMA), and sustainable sourcing. These workshops provide you with valuable knowledge and practical skills to drive sustainability in your projects.

Leadership Groups

The School is guided by our Partners' input, and they achieve outcomes by participating in exclusive Partner-only Leadership groups. These groups revolve around Construction, Homes, Facilities Management, Retrofit, Infrastructure, Scotland, Wales, as well as groups covering topics like Climate Action, Digital, Modern Slavery, Plant, Procurement, Waste, Social Values, Lean and Operational Efficiency, Interiors, Utilities, and Wellbeing.

Priority Supplier Tracker

As a Partner of the School, we recognise that you want to engage your supply chain so that they can support you in delivering your sustainability objectives. Priority suppliers may include (but are not limited to) your top spend, SMEs, or organisations that you feel will benefit from utilising the School's resources. The number of priority suppliers the School can engage with depends on the Partnership level (as detailed in the pricing pack).

Integrated E-Learning & Video Shorts

Partners gain access to the full library of 111 CPD-accredited e-learning modules and 23 video shorts (compliant with SCORM standards) developed by the School. These modules encompass a wide range of topics including sustainability, offsite practices, management, operational Excellence through lean construction, procurement, digital skills, and FIR (Fairness, Inclusion & Respect). Partners have the option to upload these e-learning modules and video shorts to their own Learning Management System (LMS).

API

The API empowers Partners to seamlessly integrate School data directly into their internal systems and keep it consistently up-to-date in realtime. This streamlines operations by eliminating the necessity for manual data downloads and reporting. Partners can use this functionality to track whether their priority suppliers are affiliated as School Members and assess their attainment levels. It's also beneficial for identifying which priority suppliers have successfully completed designated learning pathways.

Carbon Footprint Calculator (Scope 1 and 2)

Partners can utilise our free Calculator to help their supply chain to apportion carbon data to clients and monitor Scope 1 emissions (direct emissions from owned or controlled sources) and Scope 2 emissions (indirect emissions from the generation of purchased energy).

Diversity Survey

Partners can benefit from our built environment Diversity Survey and report their internal diversity metrics for free. In doing so, Partners can contribute to the largest dataset on diversity metrics in the UK and benefit from a yearly benchmarking report summarising the wider industry performance.

Lunch 'n' Learn case studies

Partners have the opportunity to present their own virtual Lunch 'n' Learn best practice case study to the wider industry through the School. As an example, Partners may wish to present about a project in which they were able to deliver sustainable benefits to their clients through their work.

Consultancy Advice Days

Partners are granted access to our expert consultants for bespoke coaching and advice across topics such as climate, modern slavery, sustainable procurement, measurement, strategy, social value, and waste.

On-Demand Course Files

The School provides Partners with on-demand course files including prerecorded webinars that comply with SCORM standards. Partners have the option to upload these videos to their own Learning Management System (LMS) if they desire.

Scope 3 Carbon Calculator

Partners are granted access to a software solution designed to gather carbon data from their supply chain, enabling them to assess and delve into their comprehensive scope 3 emissions. These emissions are further categorised by supplier and are conveniently presented through an easy-to-use dashboard.

Supply Chain EDI Benchmarking

Partners can now leverage our industry-leading EDI Measurement Solution to streamline and automate supply chain ED&I data collection. By leveraging the largest dataset on diversity metrics within the UK built environment, our team will build comprehensive and personalised benchmarking reports comparing your data to the wider industry, providing Partners with unique insight into the hotspots in their performance and informing their ESG priorities moving forward.

Bespoke Learning Pathway Quiz

The School's learning pathways serve as an easy tool for incorporating sustainability education throughout your organisation and along your supply chain. Partners can design a customisable learning pathway (including a quiz) to assess the knowledge of their priority suppliers. They offer the flexibility to tailor learning experiences to meet your company's unique goals.

Monthly User Reports

The School provides Partners with monthly reports that outline the activities of their priority suppliers, including the resources they have accessed, training sessions they have participated in, and their achievements.

Virtual Conferences

The School will run a virtual conference for a Partner on a topic of their choice and include their supply chain. For example, a Partner may wish to communicate sustainability contract requirements to a business unit or a potential supply chain.
