### 2. McLaughlin & Harvey

Carl Rushton gave a presentation on McLaughlin & Harvey's supply chain engagement looking at emissions, the net zero goals for Scope 1, 2 & 3. He set out how suppliers were engaged through a questionnaire to find out their understanding, membership of the school and recording of Co2e. Jonathan Tarr then shared the strategy to tackle this looking at supply chain data and how companies are addressing the issue in detail and responses where shared with the group.
