

Case Study: Binns Fencing

Challenges:

Binns Fencing faces a significant sustainability challenge in reducing the environmental impact of high-carbon materials, particularly steel and concrete. The business works closely with suppliers to source responsibly, using steel from trusted partner Zaun to align with its sustainability values. Further priorities include cutting site waste, refining transport logistics to curb emissions and educating the workforce in greener practices. Balancing cost pressures while investing in more sustainable materials and methods remains difficult, yet Binns Fencing views this investment as a long-term benefit to both the environment and the business.

Impact:

Engagement with the Supply Chain Sustainability School has clarified Binns Fencing's improvement pathway. Learning resources and structured assessments supported the adoption of new procurement guidelines and a more robust approach to measuring sustainability performance across projects. This has strengthened environmental practices and boosted client confidence, particularly among water and transport sector customers who increasingly prioritise sustainability credentials. Training workshops and webinars have demystified complex topics such as carbon reporting and social value, while the company's own supplier event reinforced expectations and fostered collaboration across the supply chain, encouraging greater transparency and innovation.
