

Case Study: Hire Safe Solutions Ltd

Challenges:

As a leading provider of powered access solutions, Hire Safe Solutions recognised the need to integrate sustainability into its core operations. However, several challenges needed to be addressed to achieve ambitious environmental goals. One of the primary obstacles was accurately measuring the carbon footprint. Without a clear understanding of emissions, setting realistic and achievable Net Zero targets was difficult. The transition to more sustainable equipment also posed financial and logistical challenges. While hybrid and electric-powered machinery offered long-term environmental and cost benefits, the initial investment and operational adjustments required careful planning. Additionally, ensuring compliance with evolving industry standards, such as ISO 14001 and future Net Zero regulations, demanded continuous monitoring and adaptation. Engaging employees and supply chain partners in sustainability efforts presented another challenge, as success depended on structured educational programmes and procurement practices that prioritised sustainability.

Impact:

Hire Safe Solutions took decisive action to overcome these challenges and drive measurable environmental progress. To establish a clear path to Net Zero, Hire Safe Solutions partnered with Auditel, carbon specialists, to conduct a comprehensive carbon audit. This initiative ensures that all future sustainability targets are based on accurate data, with a verified carbon footprint report set for release in July 2025. Hire Safe Solutions invested heavily in sustainable technology, maintaining a fleet in which over 80 % of the machinery is less than three years old. It became the only provider of Hybrid Boom Lifts (30 m +) and Hybrid Scissor Lifts (33 m +), reinforcing its leadership in sustainable access solutions. Recognising the importance of workforce engagement, Hire Safe Solutions has utilised the Supply Chain Sustainability School to provide training for employees. This initiative has equipped staff with critical knowledge on carbon reduction strategies, energy efficiency, and responsible resource management, enabling them to implement sustainability initiatives effectively. Additionally, Hire Safe Solutions is actively working towards becoming a member of the Plant Charter Association, further aligning its practices with industry-leading sustainability standards.
