Such written notice of the Client shall be conclusively binding on us for all purposes under this Performance Security.

Any demand for payment hereunder may be made in total or in part, without invalidating the guarantee to any sum not called. This guarantee shall expire, no earlier than twelve (12) years until the end of the Service Period of the whole of the *services* (as defined in the Contract), and any demand for payment under it must be received by us at this office on or before that date.

Any and all demands under this guarantee must either be in writing addressed to the Bank's officeor by way of authenticated swift via the Client's bankers and reaching the Bank on or before the Expiry Date.

This guarantee is subject to the Uniform Rules for Demand Guarantees (URDG) 2010 revision, ICC Publication No.758.
