

Case Study: Consider 64

Challenges:

The biggest sustainability challenges faced by Consider64 include the cost and availability of materials. Certified wood, recycled fabrics and eco-friendly finishes are often more expensive and not always easy to source. Proving that materials are truly sustainable requires certifications and audits, which can be time-consuming and costly.

Another challenge lies in customer behaviour. While many clients say they care about sustainability, most still make decisions based on price, style and delivery speed. Dealers also find it difficult to promote reuse, repair or take-back programmes in a market where fast and cheap furniture is popular. The real test is finding a way to make sustainability affordable and practical, while still meeting customer expectations.

Impact:

The Supply Chain Sustainability School action plan has been particularly valuable, providing a clear picture of where Consider64 stands today and what improvements are needed. By reviewing current activities, the business has been able to identify strengths, gaps and areas for focus. This has made it easier to set priorities and take meaningful steps that will deliver the biggest impact.
