

# Case Study: Casagrande UK

# **Challenges:**

One of Casagrande UK's key sustainability challenges was reducing energy consumption and transitioning to sustainable power sources across its operations. The business relied heavily on electricity from the national grid to power workshop tools, EV chargers, lighting, climate systems, and office equipment.

To address this, Casagrande UK invested in solar panel installations across its office, warehouse, and workshop roofs. These now provide renewable energy during daylight hours, significantly reducing reliance on grid power.

To complement this, the company replaced diesel and gas-powered equipment, including a cherry picker and forklift, with electric alternatives, introduced LED lighting, and fitted PIR (Passive Infrared) sensors to minimise energy waste. Looking ahead, Casagrande UK plans to install battery storage systems to capture excess solar energy, enabling overnight charging of equipment and servers, and enhancing overall energy resilience.

# Impact:

Engagement with the Supply Chain Sustainability School has provided Casagrande UK with valuable tools to support its sustainability journey. Introduced to the School by a customer, the company has benefited from a variety of training packages and e-learning modules that have inspired both professional and personal development.

Courses on Neurodiversity, Inclusion & Diversity, and Mental Health have been particularly influential, encouraging reflection on how team members engage with one another and improving understanding across the workforce. The Autism awareness module also had a meaningful personal impact, helping to foster greater empathy and adaptability in communication, both at work and at home.

Through this engagement, Casagrande UK has enhanced team cohesion and created a more inclusive, thoughtful working environment that supports the wellbeing of all staff.
