

Case Study: James Paul Services to Industry Ltd

Challenges:

Another key focus is ensuring that all employees understand the importance of sustainability, what it means, and how each individual can contribute towards the company's environmental goals.

Impact:

The challenge of sourcing cost-efficient materials has been addressed by creating strong relationships with suppliers who are also committed to sustainability. Increased use of recycled materials has been achieved by ensuring all wood purchased is FSC labelled, with suppliers regularly providing certification to confirm compliance. These strong supplier relationships mean recycled materials are more readily available, helping to maintain lead times and stay within budget through negotiated discounts.

Internally, James Paul Services to Industry Ltd issue every new employee with a company handbook that includes an Environmental Policy Statement outlining commitments and requirements. Regular Toolbox Talks on environmental topics are also provided, covering good practice, waste laws, prevention and minimisation, waste segregation, pollution, and energy use.

Value gained:

This knowledge informs decisions around staff vehicles, on-site machinery, materials, waste management, and office energy use.
