

Case Study: Regents Contracting Ltd

Challenges:

Subcontractors often work with materials specified by the main contractor or client, which limits their ability to influence sustainability outcomes. Without site-wide systems, subcontractors may also lack the infrastructure to sort, recycle or reuse materials effectively.

Another challenge is that many site teams are not trained in sustainable practices such as reducing water usage or minimising cement waste. This makes consistent implementation of sustainable measures across different sites difficult, despite client expectations.

Impact:

Engagement with the Supply Chain Sustainability School has enabled Regents Contracting Ltd to upskill teams through elearning and training workshops. Staff have gained practical knowledge on reducing waste, improving resource efficiency and embedding sustainability into daily operations.

Self-assessments and action plans have provided a structured way to identify gaps and track progress, while access to best-practice resources has helped the company align with client requirements and wider industry standards.

Value gained:

Membership of the School has strengthened compliance with client sustainability requirements, particularly on high-profile restoration and development projects.
